What's happening now?


- As part of our review of potential sites for the Wellbeing and Education Centre we have approached the Coromandel Colville Community Board with a request to look again at any Council land that might be suitable and available. This option will be explored alongside our current push to purchase the Wharf Road site already identified.
- We have also registered with the Companies Office as a Charitable Trust and are awaiting the outcome of our application to the Charities Commission to become a registered charity.
